Mejia: life happens with the unexpected; there should be encouragement of student voices on the board; doesn't think it's fair not to allow a report to be given even though deadlines are missed; they are very busy with work and classes.

Contreras: they are busy with working two jobs and have other leadership positions on campus; it takes one minute to pull the report up; as chair of a board, they should allow the voice of the students.

Almahdi: it's important to recognize that the deadline submission date was discussed and agreed upon; it's not acceptable to submit a report the day of the meeting; it's not fair for the individuals who did submit their reports on time; if a deadline is not going to be met and an extension is needed, there must be communication with the chair of that board.

Laura Butt: reminded board that as leaders, they need to understand that there are processes for everything; if your action is Point A, to get to Point D there are points B and C, there are processes whether you see them or not; the processing of Senate reports involves much more than just pulling them up to display on the screen, there's a lot that happens at the office operational level between submission Friday and Senate meeting Wednesday; if you need to request alternate arrangements, send an email request.
