



Title: Resolution in Support of Additional Mental Health Services for Students
Sponsored by: College of Education Senator Vanessa Coover and Senator-at-Large Logan Vournas

- WHEREAS** the Associated Students, Inc. Board of Directors of California State University, Long Beach represent a diverse campus with over 37,000 students who have experienced a variety of life experiences; and
- WHEREAS** California State University, Long Beach seeks to provide a "safe and inclusive learning and working environment for all students"¹; and
- WHEREAS** the Genocide Awareness Project shows graphic images including, but not limited to aborted fetuses, lynched bodies, dead bodies from the Holocaust, dead bodies from the Rwandan Genocide, and these images may cause students emotional distress; and
- WHEREAS** there are currently few signs on campus warning students about the graphic images they are about to see; and
- WHEREAS** there are currently no on-site resources for students to receive help if they feel that they are in emotional distress; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED** that the Office of the Dean of Students offer on-site support for students experiencing distress regarding the graphic images shown by the Genocide Awareness Project; and be it
- RESOLVED** that there be additional warning signs displayed on the grounds of the California State University, Long Beach campus including upper, middle, and lower campus informing students of the display; and be it
- RESOLVED** that Associated Students, Incorporated of California State University, Long Beach continue to work with the Office of the Dean of Students to provide these services whenever the Genocide Awareness Project is on campus; and be it finally
- RESOLVED** that we continue to represent students from all backgrounds of life and experiences by providing whatever resources are necessary for the health and safety of all 37,000 plus students.
