WHEREAS recent incidents of alleged assault and violence on campus as well as the recent national

attack on disempowered communities, has resulted in fear and distress, and therefore

compromise the good order of the educational environment; and

WHEREAS students, both those involved in Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) and the general campus

community, have expressed drive and dedication to the fight for social justice and a

progressive push by our campus community; and

WHEREAS the ASI Board of Directors is the recognized voice of California State University, Long

Beach (CSULB) students and may establish committees as needed; and

WHEREAS CSULB ASI does not currently have a sub-board that would discuss and advocate

specifically only on behalf of social justice issues; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the ASI Board of Directors mandates the creation of a sub-board starting during the

2017-2018 academic year where disempowered students can voice their own concerns

and advocate for social justice issues through ASI; and be it further

RESOLVED that Chapter II Article I of the Associated Students Bylaws be amended to include a

Section 13 titled "Social Justice and Equity Committee" which will state:

A. Scope

The Social Justice and Equity Committee will act as a liaison on behalf of the Associated Students, Incorporated on matters of social justice issues.

B. Membership

The Social Justice and Equity Committee will consist of the following voting members:

- Three Students-at-Large recommended by the committee and elected by the Senate
- 2. One faculty representative appointed by the Academic Senate
- 3. Two Senate representatives elected by the Senate
- 4. One representative from the Office of Multicultural Affairs
- 5. Chief Diversity Officer or the Secretary for Cultural Affairs
- 6. University President or designee

The Social Justice and Equity Committee will consist of the following non-voting members:

- 1. Vice President for Student Affairs or designee
- 2. ASI Executive Director or designee

C. Quorum

Quorum will consist of a majority of voting members.

D. Rules and Procedures:

The Social Justice and Equity Committee will provide for its own rules and procedures, which will be forwarded to Senate for final approval.

E. Duties and Powers

The Social Justice and Equity Committee will:

- 1. Meet bi-monthly to discuss campus climate issues regarding underrepresented communities on campus
- 2. Meet additionally as needed when incidents occur on campus
- 3. Serve as a liaison between the students, ASI Senate, and the University regarding social justice issues
- 4. Discuss and advocate for social justice issues in collaboration with ASI Senate
- 5. Serve as a board in which students can voice their concerns regarding campus climate and social justice issues
- 6. Develop programs and policies that advance social justice and equity on campus; and be it further

RESOLVED

that the ASI Board of Directors/Senate will continue to work to create a welcoming and safe campus for disempowered groups at CSULB; and be it finally

RESOLVED

that an electronic copy of this resolution, upon its approval by the ASI President be distributed to CSULB President Jane Conoley, Vice President for Student Affairs Carmen Taylor, Vice President for Administration and Finance Mary Stephens, Vice President for University Relations and Development Andrea Taylor, the Dean of Students, the California State Student Association, all current and future ASI Officers, the Daily 49er, and the Union Weekly.
