




- WHEREAS** the Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) at California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) is the single recognized voice for over 37,000 students of the university; and
- WHEREAS** the ASI Board of Directors wishes to recognize those who have served and demonstrated commitment to students and the safety of the CSULB campus; and
- WHEREAS** the ASI Board of Directors would like to acknowledge Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness for her many contributions to our students over the 40 years of her service at CSULB; and
- WHEREAS** Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness served on the ASI Board of Elections for 12 years and the ASI Board of Directors for 21 years as the University President's designee, always advocating for students' needs; and
- WHEREAS** under her position as Director for Student Life & Development from 1992 until 2003, Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness worked as the Associated Business Students Organization Council (ABSOC) advisor for many years mentoring and developing students and getting them involved with the campus community; and
- WHEREAS** Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness has served on the President's Commission on the Status of Women since the 1990s and was the Acting Director of the Women's Resource Center, constantly providing support for women and removing inequities on campus; and
- WHEREAS** Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness is currently the Associate Dean of Students at CSULB and in 2015 she received a calOES grant to cover the costs of a full time sexual assault and crisis counselor, as well as established the creation of the Not Alone @ the Beach campaign; and
- WHEREAS** that in 2016 Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness was selected as the new Title IX Coordinator because of her dedication to students and the safety of the campus community; now therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the CSULB Associated Students, Inc. Board of Directors congratulates and honors Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness for her dedication and service to ASI and the CSULB community; and be it further
- RESOLVED** that the ASI Board of Directors would like to wish Dr. Jeane Relleve Caveness all the best in her retirement; and be it finally
