President Jara joined Lobby Corps as a student-at-large for the 2016-17 year, which led her to apply and become the first Chief Government Relations Officer (CGRO) for 2017-18; and

**WHEREAS** 

her involvements in ASI culminated to her election as ASI President for the 2018-19 academic year; and

WHEREAS

as Chief Government Relations Officer, President Jara was able to accomplish the following:

- Served as the voting member for the Cal State Student Association (CSSA) Board of Directors
- Led the Long Beach efforts in fighting against the tuition increase alongside former ASI President Joe Nino
- Lobbied to state legislators and represented the best interest of students both of CSULB and the CSU system
- Prepared Lobby Corps and the other students of the Long Beach delegation for the California Higher Education Student Summit (CHESS)
- The first person to establish a policy agenda for Lobby Corps in CSULB ASI history
- Initiated the monthly CSSA recap videos to be published online and through social media to inform the campus community
- Supported and advocated for increased resources for housing and food insecure students, as well as DACA and AB540 recipients
- Led Lobby Corps in completing 8 district visits under her leadership
- Served on various university-wide search committees
- Actively sought to bring improvements and new ideas to increase resources offered to students at CSULB

- Served on the President's Commission on the Status of Women
- Led the search committee for the new ASI executive director
- Collaboratively led the search for a new and inclusive mascot
- Advocated for increased visibility of our resources to help food insecure students
- Established the "Pay it Forward" program to provide food insecure students with increased food variety
- Secured a ballot drop off location in the University Student Union for the Primary Elections to increase civic engagement
- Established and planned for the first Students of Color Conference at CSULB for Fall 2019
- Advocated for increased sustainable practices by reducing the amount of plastic straws and replace them with reusable alternatives
- Sought to increase recycling and composting efforts by creating sustainability trainings for student organizations
- Actively served on various CSSA boards to ensure representation and accountability
- Started live streaming Senate meetings for increased transparency and student engagement
- Advocated for digital course evaluations to drastically reduce paper waste
- Acquired new space on the University Physical Master Plan for the cultural resource centers
- Increased Beach Pantry usage by 300% by consistently promoting that resource through social media and SOAR presentations
- Collaboratively worked with campus entities to remove the practice of ticketing housing insecure students who sleep in their cars
- Laid the foundation to establish a transportation service for students with various abilities and different mobility needs
- Increased visibility of scholarships to increase the amount of awards granted
- Actively engaged the student body by creating the "Takis Walk," "Take a Sec with the Execs," and consistently meeting with students at-large to hear and help resolve concerns
- Worked on developing the "Fix Financial Aid" campaign on the CSU level through CSSA
