WHEREAS

the Associated Students, Incorporated (ASI) Board of Directors at California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) is the recognized voice for over 38,000 students; and

WHEREAS

it is the responsibility of the ASI Board of Directors at CSULB and the State of California to ensure the safety of its public university facilities and those occupying them; and

WHEREAS

that half of CSU infrastructures are more than forty years old and one-third are more than fifty years old; and

WHEREAS

that a 2018 Public Policy Institute of California (PPIC) report identified \$10 billion in academic infrastructure needs and \$3.7 billion in deferred maintenance needs to address an increasing need for CSU education, the construction and modernization of facilities in a manner that keeps pace with current technology and workforce demands, and expands student capacity in classrooms, laboratories and housing;² and

WHEREAS

the previous state-authorized General Obligation (GO) bonds to address infrastructure and safety needs were issued last in 2006 and exhausted by 2012;³ and

WHEREAS

AB 48 would provide essential funding to address health and safety affairs that include life, fire, seismic, safety, and deferred maintenance issues; and

WHEREAS

Assemblymember Patrick O'Donnell of the 70th Assembly District highlights students' rights to health and safety and notes the crucial educational need to learn in a safe environment that AB 48 ensures; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED

that the CSULB Associated Students Senate supports AB 48 that would place the Public Preschool, K-12, and College Health and Safety Bond Act of 2020 on the statewide primary election set for March 3, 2020; and be it further

RESOLVED

that the CSULB Associated Students Senate supports the fiscal provisions of AB 48 that would ensure the University's ability to modernize and construct facilities needed to educate, support, and serve students; and be it further

RESOLVED

that the CSULB Associated Students Senate supports Governor Gavin Newsom's signing of AB 48; and be it finally
