Patterson Child Development Center Board of Trustees are listed under letter D as "Other Officers

of the Associated Students;"2 and

WHEREAS that the Chapter II Article VI, Section 4 states that, "No student may hold more than one office

defined in Article VI, Section 1 A, B, and C;" and

WHEREAS that the Chapter II Article VI, Section 4 does not include the other officers of Associate Students

reflected in Chapter II Article VI, Section 1; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that Chapter II of the Bylaws will be edited to reflect the following change:

Article VI, Section 4 Concurrently Holding More Than One Office:

No student may hold more than one office defined in Article VI, Section 1 A, B, C, and D, and be it

further

RESOLVED that this resolution allows the Vice President the authority to reflect current changes of this

resolution throughout the AS Bylaws; and be it finally

RESOLVED that an electronic copy of this resolution, upon its approval by the ASI President be distributed to
