- Collaborated with CARECEN, the legal services on the CSULB campus, to provide informational workshops regarding DACA, TPS, and any Immigration related updates on undocumented students
- Collaborated with the Dream Success Center to increase their visibility and student engagement by using various marketing strategies
- Supported with Dream.US Student groups that focused on fostering community building for students that received the scholarship
- Envisioned Pop-Up Legal Clinics with the support of CARECEN and senators to bring tailored workshops to different colleges at CSULB
- Served as a member of the spring 2020 Undocu Conference planning committee
- Supported the student organization For Undocumented Empowered Leaders (FUEL) as the Social Media Director
- Advocated for more funding and resources towards the Dream Success Center with the executive team in the Division of Student Affairs
- Outreached to other higher education institutions with Dream Centers to bring back new ideas to better support undocumented students
- Supported with the Brown Issues Pop-Up event that took place in 2019
- Sat on the Complete Count Committee that engaged students at CSULB in learning about the Census
- Partnered with student organizations, faculty, and staff to support with the planning of the annual Undocu5k

- Advocating for the forms and policy webpage to be updated and condensed from 80 policies down to 50 by organizing the policies by chapter to provide full transparency to the student body
- Advocating for ASI to support the Black Lives Matter (BLM) movement and helped develop an educational campaign to bring awareness on how to best support our Black student community
- Leading the revision of the temporary funding policies for Student Organizations,
   Travel, and Research Grants due to COVID-19
- Revising the Financial Literacy workshops to be rebranded as the Financial Empowerment Workshops
- Developing the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS) tab for the temporary Student Organization Grant Funding Policy on the ASI Government website
- Enhancing the communication with Student Life & Development regarding funding guidelines and criteria for student organizations
- Presenting preliminary online survey results to the Division of Student Affairs
   Executive Team
- Revamping the Student Grant forms in collaboration with Student Life & Development advisors
- Leading the ASI Executive Director evaluation process
- Contributing to the ASI 2020-21 Policy Agenda on Equity, Inclusion and Racial Justice that addresses equity, inclusion, and racial justice issues with ASI's policies, procedures, programs, and services
- Effectively leading BOC through the Spring Grant Allocation process; and

that Treasurer Andrade effectively led the ASI Board of Control through an unprecedented pandemic by ensuring the board had the tools necessary to review grants and created opportunities for all students to have accessible resources to further their financial and professional success at CSULB; now therefore, be it
